FEES FOR SERVICES NOT COVERED BY THE NHS

The NHS does not cover a number of activities carried out at the surgery. The following charges will therefore apply from April 2002, in accordance with the recommendations of the BMA.

1. **MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS (including report/certificate)**
(eg, Taxi, HGV, PSV, Elderly Driver, Pilots, Employer, Fitness for Education, Sports, Seat Belt Exemptions, Court Exemption - from attending as a witness on medical grounds, Pharmaceutical trials) £92.50
2. **MEDICAL CONSULTATION REQUESTED BY PRIVATE PATIENT**
GPs and non-consultant hospital staff - **per hour, pro-rata** **£123.00**
3. **PRIVATE PRESCRIPTIONS**
 - A. The Form - (if taking to Pharmacy) £10.50
 - B. The Medicine (if dispensed from the surgery) **List Price**
4. **TRAVEL**
 - A. Insurance/Cancellation - unable to travel on grounds of ill-health £17.50 to £37.50
 - B. Private Prescription for Travel Medicine (ie The Form) £10.50
 - C. Vaccination for travel (medicine itself) - (applies only to those not claimed from the NHS) **List Price**
 - D. International Certificate of Vaccination £17.50 to £37.50
 - E. Fitness to Travel Certificate/Report prepared by GP £17.50 to £37.50
5. **CERTIFICATES/STATEMENTS OF FACT (no medical examination)**
 - A. Shotgun Licence **£16.00**
 - B. Witnessing Passport Applications £20.00
 - C. Character (eg Job) Reference £16.00
 - D. Signing New Photocard Driving Licences £20.00
 - E. Private Sick Note (Incapacity Certificate) £10.50
 - F. Accident / Sickness Insurance Certificate/Form **£10.50**
6. **REPORTS FOR INSURANCE COMPANIES**
 - A. **Private Medical Insurance Claim Forms**, to support a claim for benefit in connection with private medical insurance, or completion of a 'pre-treatment' form Norwich Union, WPA, PPP, BUPA, etc. **£20.00**
 - B. General Practitioner's Report £65.00
 - C. Medical Examiner's Report £71.00
 - D. Additional Questionnaire attached to GP's report **£15.00**
7. **ACCESS TO HEALTH RECORDS BY PATIENT**
 - A. To provide access **and** copies:
 - Records held totally on computer **£10.00**
 - Records held in part on computer and in part manually: a reasonable fee of up to **£50.00**
 - Records held totally manually; a reasonable fee of up to **£50.00**
 - B. To allow patients to **read** their records (where **no copy** is required)
 - Records held totally on computer **£10.00**
 - Records held in part on computer and in part manually **£10.00**
 - Records held totally manually (unless the records have been added to in the last 40 days when no charge can be made) **£10.00**
